# **Jackson Street Resurfacing and Restoration Project**

## **Project Title:**

Jackson Street Resurfacing and Restoration Project

## **Location:**

Jackson Street, starting on the south side of M-36 and extending south to the Bus Garage, in Dansville, Mi 48819.

## **Project Overview:**

The Jackson Street Resurfacing and Restoration Project aims to improve the condition and safety of Jackson Street, starting at the intersection with M-36 and extending south to the Bus Garage. The project will focus on road resurfacing and overall restoration of the street's infrastructure to provide a smoother driving surface, reduce maintenance costs, and improve safety for all road users. This initiative will enhance the experience for residents, commuters, and public transit vehicles while promoting long-term sustainability.

## **Project Goals:**

- **Improve Road Quality:** Resurface Jackson Street to provide a smoother, safer driving surface and reduce the frequency of potholes and other road-related issues.
- **Long-Term Durability:** Restore the road to a high standard of durability to minimize ongoing repair needs.
- **Efficient Traffic Flow:** Ensure that Jackson Street can better accommodate both local traffic and buses, especially near the Bus Garage.

## **Scope of Work:**

### **1. Road Resurfacing:**

The existing roadway will be resurfaced from the south side of M-36, extending south to the Bus Garage. This will involve the milling and removal of the existing damaged pavement followed by the application of a new asphalt surface, improving driving comfort and reducing road maintenance needs.

### **2. Roadway Restoration:**

In addition to resurfacing, sections of Jackson Street showing signs of deterioration will undergo full restoration. This includes filling in cracks, leveling uneven surfaces, and addressing any structural deficiencies in the roadway base to ensure a longer-lasting, stable road.
