

ORDINANCE NO. 16

(Enacted July 12, 1982)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 7
ENACTED NOVEMBER 17, 1981, PROHIBITING
CERTAIN DISORDERLY CONDUCT

The Village of Dansville ordains:

SECTION 1. Section 2, subsection (p), is hereby amended to read as follows:

(p) A person who resists, opposes, hinders, obstructs or interferes with the performance of duties by any police or other public official, when known to be such an official.

SECTION 2. Section 2 is hereby amended by deleting subsection (bb) in its entirety.

SECTION 3. Section 2 is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection (bb):


(bb) A person who loiters on or about any street, sidewalk, park, public building, or conducts himself in any such places, so as to obstruct or interfere with the free and uninterrupted passage of or use by the public.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days from the date of publication hereof.
