

**Village of Dansville
Meeting Minutes
March 8, 2021**

I. Call to Order: At 6:57 P.M. in Dansville Village Hall, 1360 Mason St., Dansville, MI 48819, by President Stolz.
Pledge Recited.

II. Roll Call/Present: Stolz, Barth, Ceccanese, Gailey, Kidd, Kirby, Schubert.
Non-Voting Members: Ashton, Johnson

III. Approval of Agenda: Motion to approve agenda made by Schubert, 2nd Ceccanese. Carried.

IV. Approval for February Minutes: Motion to approve minutes made by Barth, 2nd Kidd. Carried.

V. Payment of Bills: Motion to approve made by Schubert 2nd Ceccanese. Roll Call Taken - Unanimously Carried.

VI. Clerk Report: Given/Received.

VII. Communications:

- a. DDA- Stolz presented that the DDA has 10 people on the Memorial Day Committee planning the Festival to run from Friday through Monday.

VIII. Citizens/Guests Concerns:

-Ms. Colburn expressed her concern of the Village Council Meeting minutes no longer being posted on the window of the hall. Stolz responded that the Council can look into posting the meeting minutes somewhere such as the Library, but they will not be on the window. Meeting minutes are posted on the website.

-Mr. Barrett expressed concerns of the Lift Station that is on his property. It does not seem to be working correctly. Stolz will go to the property with the DPW to get more information.

-Mr. Barrett complemented the DPW on the snow plowing for this year and liking the changes and improvements the Council has been implementing.

-Mr. St. John expressed the same concerns as Mr. Barrett on the Lift Station. He is texting the DPW Director a few times each month letting him know when the alarm is going off and when there are drainage problems. Stolz will be bringing information to a future meeting to discuss.

IX. Old Business

- a. Historical Society – Gailey presented a proposal from the Historical Society asking for full use of the extra room they have already been using within the Village Hall in exchange for the Historical Society helping to pay for updates and repairs within the room. Kidd made a motion to approve this proposal, Ceccanese 2nd. Roll Call was taken, and the motion was unanimously carried. Gailey abstained from voting.
- b. Violation Letters – Stolz noted that letters will be going out soon to Village residents who are violating ordinances.

X. New Business:

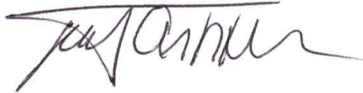
- a. Community Clean up Event – Ashton (Clerk) will work with Titans Trash and other communities who have done this event in the past for more information and details. Will present at next meeting.

- b. Village Water Billing – Stolz presented that there are a total of Eight water line dead ends within the Village. Two of those have households who currently only pay the “Ready to Serve” fee while the other six households are billed for their water usage. Stolz has spoken with the DPW and Fire Department and these two dead ends can be flushed using the Fire Hydrants rather than relying on the residents of these two households to run enough water to keep the system properly flushed. Kidd made a motion to approve this change effective immediately. Ceccanese 2nd the motion. Roll call was taken and the motion was unanimously carried.

XI. Member Concerns/Comments: Kidd presented the concern of meeting times. Meetings agendas have been full and meetings have been filled with great discussion causing meetings to run late. Stolz made a motion to change the time of meetings moving forward to 6pm. Ceccanese 2nd. The next meeting will be held at 6pm and new meeting procedures will be adopted. This information will be posted on the website.

President Stolz called for a special meeting to be held March 22nd at 6:00pm.

XII. Adjourn: Meeting adjourned at 8:35 pm – Motion made by Barth 2nd Ceccanese.
