

**Village of Dansville
Meeting Minutes
October 12th, 2020**

1. Call to Order: At 6:56 P.M. in Dansville Village Hall, 1360 Mason St., Dansville, MI 48819, by President Colburn.
Pledge Recited.

2. Roll Call/Present: Colburn, Barth, Kirby, Schubert.

3. Approval of Agenda: Motion to approve agenda made by Barth, 2nd Schubert. Carried.

4. Approval for September Minutes: Motion to approve mins made by Barth, 2nd Kirby. Carried.

5. Payment of Bills: Motion to approve made by Schubert 2nd Barth. Unanimously Carried.

6. Clerk Report: Given/Received.

7. Communications: None.

8. Citizens/Guests Concerns:

A. Noise Complaint – A few complaints were taken regarding a parked vehicle continuously revving its engine for hours at a time throughout the day. Council decided it would be best to discuss with the Village’s Lawyer to determine what actions, if any, could be taken.

B. Safety Concern – A concerned resident brought to the Council’s attention that there is a very large hole in a neighbor’s yard. Due to the size of the hole and the length of time it has been present, it is a safety hazard. The Council determined there was not much we could do at this time other than send a letter to inform the resident that others are concerned for the safety of children and animals in the community and that they would be held liable if an accident occurred.

9. Old Business

A. Lucie Fortin (Bike/Walking Trail) – Fortin presented the planning progress by the Mannick & Smith Group on the Bike/Walking Trail.

B. Halloween – The Council agreed there would be no Halloween activities, including Trunk or Treat, in the Village Hall parking lot. A motion was made by Barth and 2nd by Kirby.

C. Facebook Page – Ashton informed the Council that the Facebook Page was officially up and running.

10. New Business:

A. Ladybugs Fundraiser – The Ladybugs asked to use the Village Hall for their Annual Fundraiser. The Council agreed the Village Hall still was not able to be

rented due to COVID restrictions.

B. David Spinner – Purchase Property – If Spinner would like to bring the Council a proposal regarding the purchase of Village Property, the Council will then discuss the topic.


C. Open Trustee Position – Justin Kidd presented his interest in the open Trustee position on the Council. The Council agreed to discuss further after the upcoming elections.

Schubert made a motion to offer Kyle Budden a full-time position as a DPW Employee. Budden would take on some of Ward's old responsibilities including water. Budden will have 18 months to complete the needed certifications for water. Barth 2nd. Unanimously Carried.
