

ORDINANCE NO. 12

(Enacted March 8, 1982)

AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL FIREARMS

The Village of Dansville ordains:

SECTION 1. Unlawful to Discharge Firearms.

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge or use any firearms, air-rifles, slingshots or any other dangerous weapons within the Village limits of Dansville at any time.

SECTION 2. Police and Military Exception.

This Ordinance shall not apply to any peace officer or military personnel acting in the official discharge of their duties. Nor shall this Ordinance apply to any citizen acting in reasonable defense of his person or property.

SECTION 3. Penalty for Violation.

Any person convicted of any violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine not exceeding Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, and/or by imprisonment for any period up to ninety (90) days.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days from and after the passage thereof.
