

ORDINANCE NO. 14

(Enacted July 12, 1982)

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE CONDUCT
OF PERSONS USING VILLAGE STREETS AND PROPERTY

The Village of Dansville ordains:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to be in an intoxicated condition in or on any street, alley, park or public parking area or lot in the Village.

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to consume any intoxicating liquor in or on any street, alley, park or public parking area or lot in the Village.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to possess any open intoxicants in or on any street, alley, park or public parking area or lot in the Village.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to possess, consume or ingest, in any manner, any controlled substance in or on any street, alley, park or public parking area or lot in the Village.

SECTION 4. Any person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars or by imprisonment of not more than ninety (90) days or both.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days from the date of publication hereof.
