

ORDINANCE NO. 20

(Enacted October 11, 1982)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 13
TO REGULATE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE
VILLAGE OF DANSVILLE

The Village of Dansville ordains:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 13 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, association or corporation to park or leave stopped any motor vehicle in excess of or between the times specified below on the streets specified therein:

(a) In excess of two continuous hours between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on the north side of Cook Street; Adams from Dakin to Grove; the east side of Jackson between Cook and Chestnut Streets.

(b) Between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 2:00 a.m. on the east side of Jackson between Cook and Adams Streets except when authorized by appropriate Village officials or when the adjoining property is open to use by the general public.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication.
