

ORDINANCE NO. 2

(Enacted June 17, 1981)

AN ORDINANCE TO FIX THE COMPENSATION
FOR THE PRESIDENT, TRUSTEES AND OTHER OFFICERS
OF THE VILLAGE OF DANSVILLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH
SEC. 21 OF ACT 3, P.A. 1895

The Village of Dansville ordains:

SECTION 1. The President of the Village shall receive the sum of Thirty-five (\$35.00) Dollars for each regular and special meeting of the Village Council by him or her attended during his or her term of office.

SECTION 2. The Trustees of the Village shall each receive the sum of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars for each regular or special meeting of the Village Council by them respectively attended during their term of office.

SECTION 3. The Clerk of the Village shall receive the sum of Five Hundred Twenty-five (\$525.00) Dollars per year during his or her term of office.

SECTION 4. The Treasurer of the Village shall receive the sum of Three Hundred Seventy-five (\$375.00) Dollars per year during his or her term of office.

SECTION 5. All payments for such compensation shall be made out of the general fund of the Village treasury and for the President and Trustees paid monthly and for the Clerk and Treasurer paid yearly.

SECTION 6. The President and Trustees shall receive no other compensation for services performed for and on behalf of the Village during the term of their office and in no case shall any officer specified herein receive compensation for any meetings not actually attended.

SECTION 7. The Clerk and Treasurer may receive such additional compensation as the Council may from time to time prescribe by appropriate resolution.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication.
