

VILLAGE OF DANSVILLE
ORDINANCE NO. 43
OVERNIGHT PARKING IN VILLAGE LOTS

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT OVERNIGHT PARKING OF ANY VEHICLE IN ANY VILLAGE OWNED PARKING LOT WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF DANSVILLE, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE VILLAGE OF DANSVILLE ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: No vehicle shall be allowed to park overnight in any Village owned parking lot.

SECTION 2: Violation of Ordinance will result in removal of vehicle from parking lot.

SECTION 3: The Village of Dansville assumes no responsibility for damage to vehicles that are in violation.

SECTION 4: Upon complaint from any person, the Zoning Administrator, or designee, shall attempt to notify owner in person, or by mail, to remove vehicle from lot. Owner must remove vehicle within 5 days of receipt of notice.

SECTION 5: Any person who fails to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall be responsible for a civil infraction as defined by MCL 600.113 and subject to a fine of no more than \$100.00 and responsible for the cost of vehicle removal.

SECTION 6: The Village President, Treasurer or Clerk are authorized to take whatever steps necessary to carry out the terms of this ordinance and recover any monetary losses the Village may incur.

SECTION 7: Severability; The foregoing regulations of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, or phrase is judged to be unconstitutional or invalid, it is hereby provided that the remainder of the provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 8: Effective Date: This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its adoption and publication.
