ORDINANCE NO. 46

**PREAMBLE**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 13 TO APPLY TO VEHICLES, TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF TRUCKS AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF DANSVILLE; AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

The Village of Dansville, Ingham County, Michigan, ordains:

**Section 1. Amendment of Ordinance No. 13, Section 1.**

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 13 shall be and is hereby amended to read:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, association or corporation to park or leave stopped any vehicle on any Village street between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 1 to March 1.

**Section 2. Amendment of Ordinance No. 13, Section 2.**

Section 2 of Ordinance No. 13 shall be and is hereby amended to read:

SECTION 2.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, association or corporation to park or leave stopped, any vehicle in excess of two (2) continuous hours between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on the following streets: Jackson Street between Cook Street and Chestnut Street, the North side of Cook Street, Adams Street from Dakin Street to Grove Street, the North side of South Street from Grove Street to the Dansville High School.

(b) No truck (as defined by MCL 257.75, as amended), trailer, semi-trailer, tractor or other such type of vehicle shall be parked within the limits of any Village street or

other public place, except public parking lots, for a period of greater than one (1) hour during the hours from sunset to sunrise, and then only if such vehicle is lighted with two (2) headlights and two (2) red rear lights so constructed and placed as to be observed under ordinary atmospheric conditions at a distance not less than five hundred (500) feet.

**Section 3. Amendment of Ordinance No. 13, Section 3.**

Section 3 of Ordinance No. 13 shall be and is hereby amended to read:

SECTION 3.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, association or corporation to park or leave stopped, any vehicle at any time on the following streets: the West side of Jackson Street from Adams Street to Cook Street, the South side of Cook Street, the South side of South Street West of Grove Street, the North and South sides of Johnson Street.

(b) No vehicle used in the transportation of inflammable or explosive materials or substances shall be parked within the limits of any Village street or other public place during the hours from sunset to sunrise, provided, however, that this restriction shall not apply to the incidental stopping or parking such vehicle in the carrying out of loading or unloading operations or in the performance of errands incidental to the business use of such vehicles if such vehicle is lighted with at least two (2) white headlights and two (2) red rear lights so constructed and placed as to be observed under ordinary atmospheric conditions at a distance not less than five hundred (500) feet.

**Section 4. Repealer.**

All portions of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 5. Effective Date.**

This Ordinance shall become effective following adoption and publication.
