

ORDINANCE NO. 6

(Enacted June 17, 1981)

AN ORDINANCE PROTECTING THE STREETS,
ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC PLACES IN THE
VILLAGE OF DANSVILLE

The Village of Dansville ordains:

SECTION 1. No person shall make any excavation, place any obstruction, lay or replace any pipes, or place any poles in any public place in the Village of Dansville, or dig or tear up any pavement, or dig any hole, ditch or sewer in any sidewalk, street, alley or any public place, or cause the same to be done, without first obtaining permission from the Village Council.

SECTION 2. Before granting permission, the Village Council shall establish reasonable standards under which any work in or on any street, alley, sidewalk, or public place shall be performed, including the time within which such work shall be completed, and may require the applicant to furnish security for the faithful performance of the work in accordance with the established standards and to pay such sums as the Council shall prescribe to adequately compensate the Village for necessary expense incurred in connection with the application, establishment of standards and any necessary inspections of the work.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall not apply to any governmental unit nor to any public utility regulated by the State of Michigan or a subdivision thereof for any work required to be done thereby in the Village of Dansville.

SECTION 4. Any violation of, or failure to comply with, the provisions of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof punishable by a fine of up to Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars together with costs of prosecution or imprisonment in the County Jail for up to ninety (90) days or both, in the discretion of the District Court.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its approval by the Village Council.
