ORDINANCE NO. 9

(Enacted March 8, 1982)

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO TREES IN PUBLIC PLACES IN THE VILLAGE OF DANSVILLE

The Village of Dansville ordains:

SECTION 1. No shade or ornamental tree shall be planted in any of the public places of the Village of Dansville without first obtaining a permit to do so from the Village Council or its designee.

SECTION 2. No person shall remove, destroy, break, cut off, trim or in any way injure or interfere with, nor attach any rope, wire, cable, sign, card or poster to any tree located in any public place within the Village of Dansville without first obtaining a permit to do so from the Village Council or its designee.

SECTION 3. The owner of any property on which stands any tree, the branches of which extend over a public highway or sidewalk in the Village of Dansville, shall keep said tree cut off ten (10) feet above the surface of said highway or sidewalk.

SECTION 4. Any violation of, or failure to comply with, the provisions of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof punishable by a fine of up to Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars together with costs of prosecution or imprisonment in the County Jail for up to ninety (90) days or both, in the discretion of the District Court.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its approval by the Village Council.
